

ALTHOUGH THESE ARE DIFFICULT TIMES, WE HOPE YOU WILL FEEL WELCOME IN OUR CHURCH

From Wednesday 17 June 2020 our village church of St Peter in the Wood will be open for private prayer. For your safety and to meet the restrictions placed on us by the Government and the Church of England, Church opening times will be limited to **Sundays between 9am and 12 noon and Wednesdays between the hours of 1pm and 5pm.**

WE WOULD ASK YOU TO PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES

If you or anyone in your family develop or have developed symptoms of Covid-19 please do not enter.

If you are over 70 and/or shielding it is recommended that perhaps you shouldn't come in at the current time.

Although open for private prayer we would ask that unless you are in a family group, there be no more than one person in the building at any time.

Many places, including the balcony, are roped off, we would ask you to respect these closed areas.

Please:

- use the hand gel provided in the porch (or your own) before entering the Church and upon leaving.
- wear a face covering or mask and try to avoid touching anything but the pews.
- wipe over your pew after use and dispose of your rubbish in the bin provided or take it home with you.
- record the date, your name and telephone number. You will only be contacted if someone later finds they have Covid-19.
- use your own pen or wipe and use pen provided.

As Church of England guidelines develop the PCC will amend this advice.
